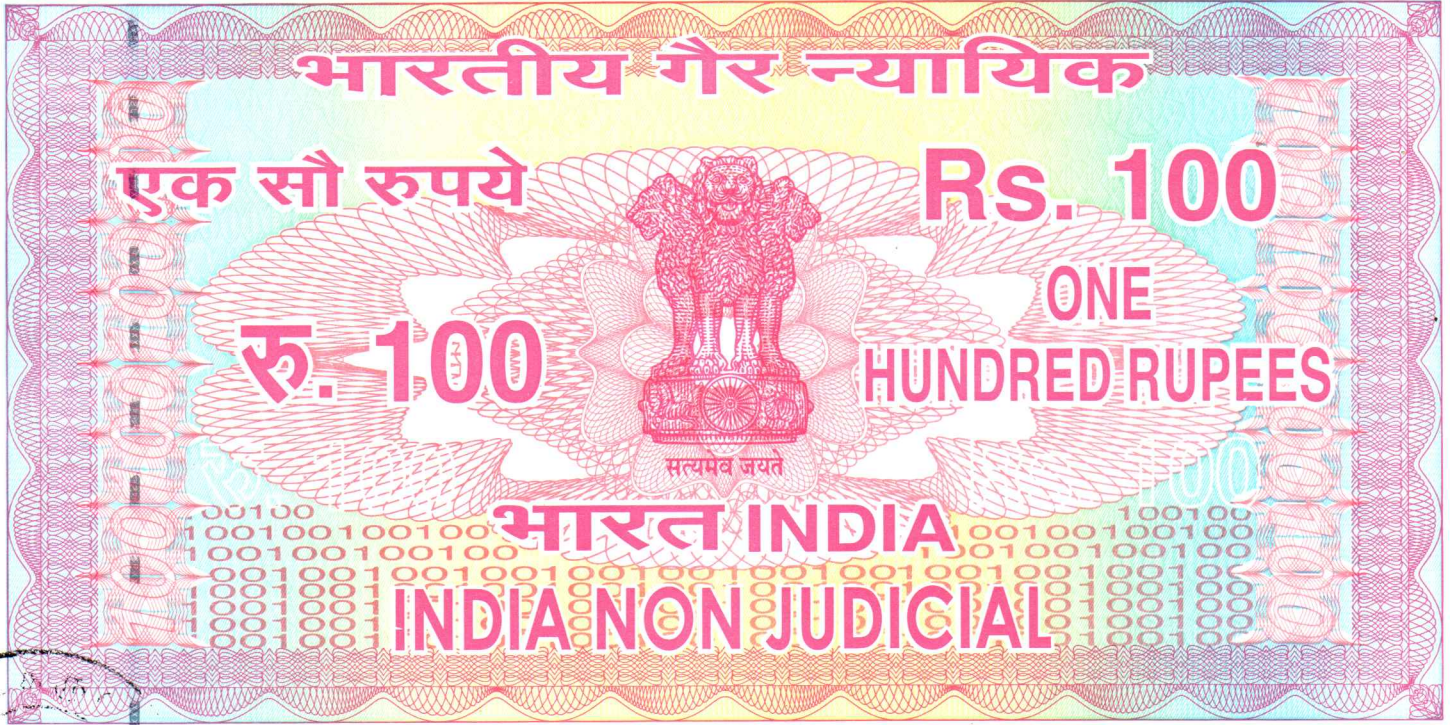

**Hindustan Group of Institutions** is in the field of Technical Education for the past six decades specialized particularly in the area of Aeronautical & Aerospace Engineering and Automotive Engineering.

**Indian Institute of Information Technology Manipur** is an institution under Ministry of Higher Education, Govt. of India. IIIT Manipur was established in 2015 in order to develop Manipur as preferred destination for Information Technology (IT) related manpower and industry. This shall enable Manipur to gear up for providing IT related services as well as high-quality Research & Development in IT. IIITM offers B.Tech in Computer Science and Engineering (CSE) and Electronics and Communication Engineering (ECE) and PhD in CSE, ECE and Humanities and Basic Sciences from its city campus located at Mantripukhri, Imphal. Although a new institute, the campus has adequate classrooms, laboratories for CSE and ECE, conference hall, playground, hostels, faculty quarters, guest house and own administrative offices. The excellent student-faculty ratio enables 360-degree technical supervision and personal development of each student. IIITM is one of the 20 IIITs set up by the Government of India in PPP mode. Being an Institute of National Importance, IIITM strives to be attentive to academic needs of every student. Institute-wide WiFi connectivity empowered students to explore about the life-changing tools 24x7.



## **Article 1. OBJECTIVES**

The objectives of this interaction are many and would evolve with time and the quality of inputs provided by both the parties. At the outset the following can be envisaged on the non-financial implications, it will be mutually agreed on a case to case basis.

Hence HGI & IIITM agree,

**(i) To offer Internship / Real-Time Projects to Under Graduate, Post Graduate students and Research Scholars through Phydigital mode.**

For this, HGI and IIITM will identify Real-Time projects in different streams for B.Tech and M. Tech students and Research Scholars. Number of students & the distribution among the various branches of engineering will be made available well in advance by IIITM and HGI. The selection of these students will be completed at least two weeks prior to commencement of Projects at IIITM. Number of students would be decided on merit.

- a. Students for the Projects will be selected by IIITM through the interview mode as designed by the Parties.
- b. IIITM and HGI will designate one of their officers / Faculty Members as coordinators for student projects to continuously monitor the progress of these Projects. IIITM will provide the list of Projects and students to HGI after the selection of students.

**(ii) To Jointly carry out Research and Development Projects**

A dedicated team from HGI and IIITM will engage in research and consultancy projects in the various specialised areas of Engineering, Technology, Science & Humanities by mutual discussion. Research & Consultancy Projects and Training in the emerging areas especially in the areas of 5G / 6G Communication after the establishment of Centre of Excellence in 5G / 6G Communication lab at Hindustan Institute of Technology and Science by IIITM and HGI jointly.

**(iii) To Jointly conduct Certified Training Courses**

The parties have agreed to explore on providing certified industry based training courses in the various specialised areas of Engineering, Technology, Science & Humanities, placement linked courses jointly and finishing school courses under IIITM emerging areas projects jointly.



**(iv) To Jointly carry out Technology Business Incubator in association with IITM**

For this, HGI will identify its incubatees with funding support from both HGI and IITM and encourage start-ups in the cutting edge technologies in association with leading industries jointly.

**(v) To Jointly conduct conferences, seminars, workshops and symposia's**

The parties have agreed to conduct national / international conferences, seminars, workshops and symposia's jointly.

**Article 2. CONFIDENTIALITY**

Any information declared confidential, and documents exchanged between the Parties pursuant to this MoU shall not, under any circumstances, be released by the receiving Party to any other third party or to the public, without the prior written consent of the disclosing Party. This rule is obligatory for each Party for a period of **Five (5) years**, from the date of termination of this MoU.

**Article 3. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS**


The parties recognize the intellectual property rights of each other in the materials to be delivered in connection with the programme to be carried out and agree not to publish without any written permission, any patent / copyright, trademark, registration application in its own name or in the name of its associates on any matter relating to the details supplied / disclosed by the other party, nor take any other action that may prejudicially affect such intellectual property rights.

The ownership of the intellectual property rights in the work carried out under the Programme shall be mutually shared as agreed by this MoU.

**Article 4. TERMINATION**

This agreement shall, unless otherwise extended by mutual agreement of the parties, shall terminate upon happening of any of the following events:

- i. Termination by mutual consent or
- ii. Termination by either Party due to breach of any of the covenants hereof by the other
- iii. Either party may terminate the agreement by written notification signed by the appropriate official of the Institution initiating the notice. Such notice must be received by the other party **Six (6) months** prior to the effective termination date.



However, obligations and commitments already contracted for and involving their parties shall be honoured and continued by both parties until such commitments are completed. If the training or projects are undergoing, then a notice will be given either from HGI or IIITM, for termination and post completion of training tenure/period, the termination will be effective.

#### **Article 5. VALIDITY**

This MoU shall be valid initially for a period of **FIVE (5) years**, from the date of signing by both Parties and can be extended further by mutual consent.

#### **Article 6. NOTICES**

Any notice and other communications served in relation to this MoU shall be in English and delivered personally, by email, by courier or by postage prepaid registered post.

All notices shall be deemed to have been validly given on (i) if transmitted by facsimile or email transmission, the day immediately after the date of facsimile or email transmission with confirmed answer back, or (ii) if sent by registered post with acknowledgement due or by courier, the date of receipt.,

Any Party may, from time to time, change its address or representative for receipt of notices provided for in this Agreement by giving to the other not less than 15 (fifteen) days prior written notice.

#### **Article 7. FORCE MAJEURE**

Neither Party will be liable for inadequate performance to the extent caused by a condition (for example, natural disaster, act of war or terrorism, riot, labour condition, governmental action, and Lockdowns) that was beyond the Parties reasonable control.

#### **Article 8. GOVERNING LAW**

The laws of Republic of India shall govern this MoU. The jurisdiction of this will be Chennai.

#### **Article 9. DISPUTE SETTLEMENT**

Disputes if any, arising between the Parties, in connection with this MoU or any other matters connected therewith, the same will be mutually discussed and amicably settled between the parties, failing which, the disputes shall be referred to Arbitration in accordance with the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and Rules framed there under from time-to-time. The place of Arbitration shall be at **Chennai / Manipur**, India and the Arbitration proceedings shall be conducted in English language.




**Article 10. AMENDMENT**
