MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

In order to promote co-operation between National Institute of Technology Nagaland (hereinafter referred to as **NIT Nagaland**) and Indian Institute of Information Technology Senapati, Manipur (hereinafter referred to as **IIIT Manipur**), the two institutions agree as follows:

1. The two institutions will encourage direct contact and co-operation between their faculty and administrative staff, departments and research Laboratories/Centers/Cells.
2. Within fields that are mutually acceptable, the following general forms of co-operation will be pursued:
 - A) Visits by and exchange of faculty members, research scholars, and students.
 - B) Joint research activities and joint supervision of research work.
 - C) Joint conferences or symposia on subjects of mutual interest.
 - D) Joint educational outreach activities.
 - E) Semester exchanges and internship opportunities for the students of the undergraduate programme (at least 5 students at a time with prior approval)
3. It is agreed that the terms and conditions of any agreed programme and activity contemplated in this MoU shall be the subject matter of separate written agreements to be negotiated and agreed upon by both Parties and/or any third parties, wherever applicable. PROVIDED ALWAYS the decision whether to initiate and/or implement any programme or activity shall be at the sole discretion of each Party.
4. This memorandum is not intended to create binding or legal obligations on either party. It merely expresses the intentions and understanding of the Parties which will form the basis of any legally binding agreement to be drafted and executed in the future.
5. All financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds and approval from the respective concern authority.


6. The Parties agree and undertake to keep confidential at all times any information or data that may be exchanged, acquired or shared in connection with any programme or activity conducted pursuant to this MoU save where the same is already in public domain.
7. The Memorandum of Understanding grants to either party any right or license to use the other party's name, logos, or other trademarks, will be considered in a mutually-agreed fashion.
8. The MoU is initially valid for a period of three years. If there is a satisfactory progress in the work envisaged here, the MoU may be extended for a longer period. It may be terminated at any time by mutual consent or by three (3) months' notice in writing by either party.
9. Any on-going collaborative activities be affected by termination; the parties undertake to resolve any issue amicably by mutual agreement without any reference to a third party.
10. Every notice, request or any other communication required or permitted to be given pursuant to this MoU shall be in writing, in English and delivered personally or sent by registered or certified post via air mail or by courier or email (which shall be acknowledged by the other Party) to the Parties at the addresses stated below:
