**Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made and entered into on this day **30<sup>th</sup> October 2025**, by and between **Indian Institute of Information Technology Manipur** (hereinafter referred to as "IIITM"), having its office at Mantripukhri, Heingang, Imphal East District Pin No 795002 and **CubeTen technologies Private Limited** (hereinafter referred to as "CubeTen"), having its office at Manipur Information Technologies Park, Mantripukhri, Imphal East District Pin No. 795002.

This MoU is established between IITM and CubeTen with the objective of fostering an **Academic-Industry Alliance (AIA)**. This partnership aims to collaborate on IT-related projects and research in the fields of Computer Science Engineering (CSE), Electronics and Communication Engineering (ECE), and the Internet of Things (IoT). The primary goal is to enhance the educational experience of students by promoting research collaboration, and developing industry-relevant skills to better prepare students for professional opportunities and thus the two parties agree as follow:

1. Internship Opportunities:

- CubeTen will provide internship opportunities for students of IITM in various IT-related fields.
- The internships will be designed to give students practical experience and exposure to real-world projects.
- Placement offers based on the merit of the student from relevant discipline.
- Financial involvements may be discussed based on the type and sessions.
- There can be a limited minimum number of seats that can be guaranteed for internship

2. Engagement in IT Projects:

- Both parties will collaborate on various IT projects, including but not limited to software development, research and development (R&D) in emerging technologies, and IoT-based solutions.
- The parties will explore opportunities for students to contribute to ongoing projects or propose new ones.
- Faculty from IITM and industry experts from CubeTen will jointly supervise and guide students working on these projects.


3. Technology and Knowledge Exchange:

- The two parties will engage in continuous technology and knowledge exchange to stay up-to-date with the latest trends and advancements in the IT industry.
- Both parties will jointly conduct workshops, seminars, and guest lectures at IITM, sharing industry best practices, emerging technologies, and real-time case studies.
- IITM faculty and students will have the opportunity to collaborate with CubeTen on research, product development, and technology innovation.



4. Collaborative Academic and Industry Engagement:

- The collaboration will facilitate the creation of joint academic programs, certification courses, and research initiatives that align with the current demands of the industry.
  - Both parties will collaborate on research initiatives and co-author publications, including research papers, case studies, and technical articles, for submission to reputed national and international journals and conferences.
  - Both parties will work together to create a platform for academic-industry engagement, ensuring that students receive a comprehensive learning experience that bridges the gap between academia and industry.
5. This memorandum is not intended to create binding or legal obligations on either party. It merely expresses the intentions and understanding of the Parties which will form the basis of any legally binding agreement to be drafted and executed in the future.
  6. Both parties may either enter into a separate MoU or use this MoU based on the Projects which may be finalized with due discussion between the two parties.
  7. Both parties understand that all financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds.
  8. The Parties agree and undertake to maintain strict confidentiality at all times with regard to any information or data exchanged, acquired, or shared in connection with any program or activity conducted pursuant to this MoU. This obligation of confidentiality shall not apply to information that is already in the public domain or that which the Parties are required to disclose by law or regulation.
  9. Nothing in this MoU grants to either party any right or license to use the other party's name, logos, or other trademarks except in a mutually-agreed fashion
  10. Any amendments to this MOU must be made in writing and signed by both parties. No changes or modifications to this MOU will be valid unless agreed upon in writing.
  11. The MoU is initially valid for a period of three years. If there is satisfactory progress in the work envisaged here, the MoU may be extended for a longer period. It may be terminated at any time by mutual consent or by one (1) months' notice in writing by either party
  12. Should ongoing collaborative activities be affected by termination, the parties undertake to resolve any issue amicably by mutual agreement without any reference to a third party.



13. Upon termination, both parties will ensure an orderly conclusion of ongoing activities, including the submission of final reports and the resolution of any outstanding matters.

Every notice, request or any other communication required or permitted to be given pursuant to this MoU shall be in writing, in English and delivered personally or sent by registered or certified post via air mail or by courier or email (which shall be acknowledged by the other Party) to the Parties at the addresses stated below

### Tenure of MoA

This Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) shall come into effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of Octoberr, 2025, and shall remain in force until the 29<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2028. Upon the expiry of the said duration, the Parties may review, extend, or renew this MoA on such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon between them.




